

## **Signs of Safety 3 day Training**

The NELC 3 day Signs Of Safety (SOS) Course is:

- An interactive practice based course.
- Developed specifically for participants who wish to gain an understanding of the SOS model.
- Have the opportunity to practice and develop their skills in the core elements of the Signs of Safety approach through Live Case Mapping.
- Suitable for individuals who are beginners / new members of staff who may have little understanding of the SOS approach.
- For individuals who have previously undertaken SOS training and would like to update, refresh and / or develop their skills and knowledge further.

**The Aims of this training are;** For you to gain an awareness and practice experience of the Signs Of Safety (SOS) Model, exploring 'why' and 'how' SOS is being embedded within NELC.
